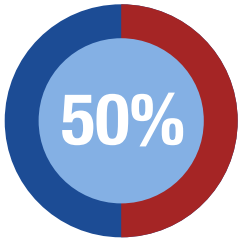

Harmful use of alcohol

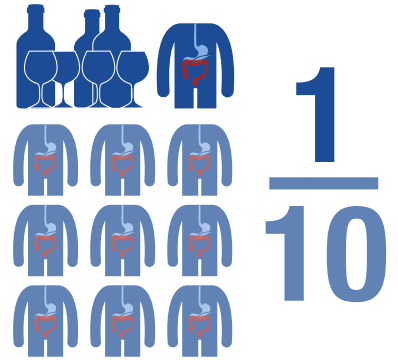


Harmful use of alcohol accounts for up to **half of all liver cancer** cases in Europe⁽¹⁾

Colorectal Cancer

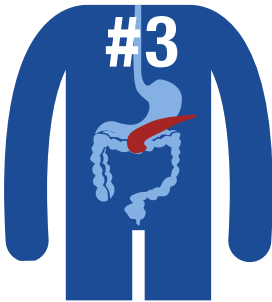


Colorectal cancer is the **second most common cancer** in Europe⁽²⁾

Pancreatic Cancer



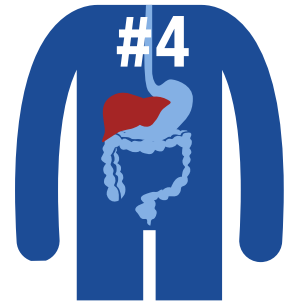
Pancreatic cancer is the **third biggest cancer killer** in Europe⁽³⁾

Alcohol Consumption



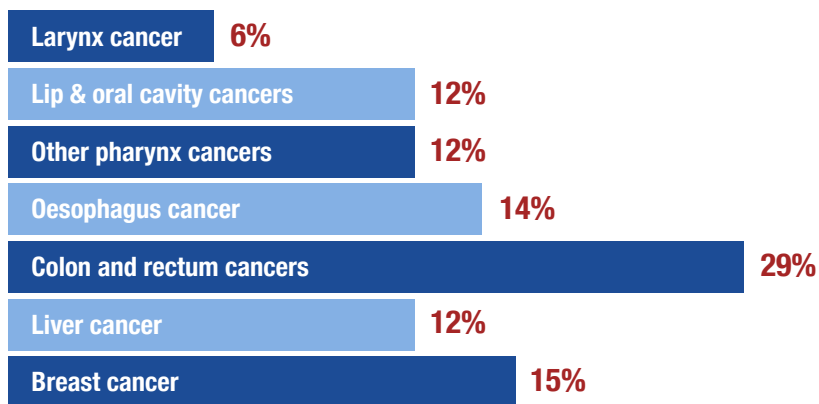
The consumption of 50 gr. of alcohol increases the **risk of colorectal cancer** by 10-20%⁽⁶⁾

Liver Cancer



Liver cancer is the **4th leading cause** of cancer-related deaths worldwide, being the **2nd and 6th most common cause** of cancer death⁽⁴⁾

Oesophageal cancer is the **sixth largest cancer killer** worldwide⁽⁸⁾
