- Considering the regional representation of group members in 2022, applicants from Belgium, Germany, Portugal, Turkey and the United Kingdom cannot be considered.
- Candidates do not necessarily have to be active members of UEG Member Societies or National Societies.
- Previous experience in comparable volunteer work is an asset.

Process to become a member

Interested candidates are asked to

- Read the [role description](#) to make sure they fulfil the requirements for application
- Browse the UEG website to familiarise themselves with what UEG is already doing for young specialists
- Seek support from their head of department
- Complete the [online application form](#)

Important: Applications that do not fulfil the following two requirements will be rejected outright:

- CV must fit on one page
- Confirmation from the head of department must include the sentence: the candidate would be allowed to take the position according to the duties outlined in the role description (incl. UEG Week and relevant business meetings attendance)

Deadline for applications: March 18, 2022

All applicants will be reviewed by the current YTG members in terms of the applicants' motivation, ideas, and previous experience in comparable volunteer work. In addition, applications will also be discussed individually to achieve regional and gender balance, as well as a broad representation of all specialisations in gastroenterology (incl. basic science, surgery etc.) of the group. The final selection must be approved by the National Societies Committee.

All applicants will be notified of their application results by June 2022. Successful candidates should be prepared to attend meetings (especially at UEG Week) already before their term officially starts, to get to know the group and their activities.
