The online phase is carefully aligned with the topics and cases covered at the in-person event to provide an integrated learning experience. Participants will work together in multidisciplinary groups to solve clinical cases presented at the face-to-face meeting.

The culmination of this blended learning experience will be a 2-day face-to-face event in Vienna, Austria, featuring:

- Multidisciplinary case-based learning
- World-class faculty
- A mix of teaching formats, e.g., case studies, discussion, group work, quizzes, panels etc.
- Opportunities for networking and exchange with a multidisciplinary peer group and faculty

The two days will be structured into sections covering the following topics:

- 3) Local complications
  - a) Pseudo cysts
  - b) Biliary obstructions
- 4) Pancreatic insufficiency and cancer
- 5) Setting up a multidisciplinary chronic pancreatitis service
