Workshop Concept

At 5 stations participants will discuss with an experienced gastroenterologist and a surgeon the most important information to give to the surgeons on a clinical finding or treatment to improve patient care and to better collaborate with surgeons. Each station covers a different topic, and all discussions are case-based and illustrated with videos and/ or images.

Participants will rotate through all 5 stations and **must attend the entire course**.

Learning objectives

Basic knowledge of:

- The pre-operative work up for various diagnoses in the GI tract.
- The information the surgeon needs to decide on the next treatment plan.
- The rationale of surgical decision-making.
- The most common challenges surgeons face in patients referred by gastroenterologists; tips, tricks and pitfall avoidance.

Topics

- Diagnosis and treatment of complications of upper GI surgery

- Endoscopically non-resectable colonic polyps and colon cancer
- Mass forming pancreatic lesion: How to decide it is not a surgeon's issue?
- Proctological emergencies
- Staging of gastric and oesophageal cancer
