1. Call

UEG Journal is calling for 10-15 new Trainee Editors.

Term of office: January 2025 - December 2026

Each Trainee Editor will take one or more of these tasks:

- Peer review **IBD**, assisting an Associate Editor (2 Trainee Editors)
- Peer review **Hepatology**, assisting an Associate Editor (1)
- Peer review **Pancreas**, assisting an Associate Editor (1)
- Peer review **Endoscopy**, assisting an Associate Editor (1)
- Peer review Oncology, assisting an Associate Editor (1)
- Peer review Clinical images (2)
- Social media and marketing, e.g. maintaining the professional @UEGJournal Twitter handle (2-3)
- Search engine optimisation (2)
- Visual abstracts, creating in collaboration with an illustrator (3)
- Podcast, incl. organising, recording and editing (2)
- Website handling, providing content for the journal page on the publisher's website (1)

2. Application criteria

Candidates must

- be digestive health specialists with an MD or basic/clinical scientists at pre/post PD/PhD level
- be fluent in English writing
- reside in Europe, in a country bordering the Mediterranean Sea, or in a country represented by a <u>UEG</u> National Member Society
- be <u>myUEG Young GI Associates</u>¹
- have at least 3 publications (as a first author, published in international, peer reviewed, indexed journals; case reports and reviews excluded)
- have an interest in learning about the publishing process and participating in the editorial process of UEG Journal
- be reliable, able to work within short timelines, respond to emails quickly
- be aware of the workload, 10-20 reviews a year, plus additional responsibilities
- be able to maintain courteous and effective professional/working relationships with authors, editors and the publisher

Trainee Editors get the opportunity to be introduced into the editing process, therefore previous experience on an editorial board of a medical journal is not required.

3. Application

To apply, please complete the online application form. This form includes:

- Information about yourself and your research (institution, professional background, field of interest)
- Research focus pitch: Your research focus in one sentence
- CV (upload): To be accepted, your CV can be max. 1 A4 page long, and must include a short summary of your medical/scientific education, as well as a manuscript list (see next page for further specifications)
- Your 3-5 most important publications in indexed journals (excluding reviews and case reports)
- Motivation statement (max. 400 words): Describe why you want to become a Trainee Editor, refer to your clinical and/or scientific research interest
- Tasks you are interested in (see item 1. above)
- Your previous experience in the publishing world (editing, reviewing, writing)
