

Role description for the position of National Societies Representative to the Meeting of Members

The Meeting of Members (MoM)

The MoM consists of 51 representatives from Ordinary (i.e. Specialist) Member Societies and 30 representatives from National Member Societies. The latter are elected to the MoM by the National Societies Forum (NSF). The MoM convenes at least once a year to discuss and pass resolutions, approve the admission of new members, elect major UEG officers, and get up to date on UEG business.

Role Description

Tasks of the National Societies Representatives to the Meeting of Members

- Representing the voice of <u>all</u> UEG National Member Societies
- Facilitating information transfer between the Meeting of Members and the National Societies Forum
- Supporting future strategies and activities for UEG and the National Member Societies
- Maintaining a good two-way communication with their national society

Person Specification

National Societies Representatives to the Meeting of Members

- have broad experience in gastroenterology and related fields
- acquire and maintain a good understanding of UEG's structure and mission and are ready to share responsibility in shaping the future of the organisation
- are ready to promote UEG's initiatives and disseminate information
- provide good organisational skills and show the ability to work across organisational and cultural boundaries
- have good command of spoken and written English
- are <u>myUEG Associates</u> or <u>myUEG Young GI Associates</u> who make regular and proficient use of provided online tools to help strengthen the community
- reside in Europe and the Mediterranean area (countries that are bordering the Mediterranean Sea)

Volunteer time commitment

National Societies Representatives to the MoM shall be willing and able to spend a decent amount of time on fulfilling their role. They must prepare for and follow-up on three meetings a year (MoM and NSF, held in-person, hybrid, or virtually), ad hoc extra-ordinary meetings if needed, and stay in e-mail contact. Personal meeting attendance is mandatory and usually requires travelling to Vienna and other European meeting venues.
