- Travel grants are awarded on the basis of scientific merit using the evaluation process of the Scientific Committee. UEG offers 510 travel grants of up to € 750 to clinical and basic scientists of 40 years of age and below (born on October 8, 1985 and later) for best submitted abstracts. You will need to apply for these at the same time as submitting the abstract. The grant can only be awarded once per abstract presenter per meeting. This application is only available for myUEG Young GI Associates.
- National Scholar awards provide recognition for promising junior level researchers.
 With this award we identify and nurture promising investigators at a junior level (abstract presenters 40 years of age and below, born on October 8, 1985 and later). Among all abstracts accepted for presentation at UEG Week, the highest scoring abstracts per country are chosen.
 Awardees will receive a travel grant.
 This opportunity is only available for myUEG Young GI Associates.
- Best Abstract Presentation Prizes are awarded in the spirit of prestige rather than monetary gain.
 These prizes are awarded in every Abstract-based session as well as in the Moderated Poster sessions by the session chairs and take into consideration scientific quality and overall delivery of the presentation.
