

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Why submit your abstract?

Prestigious awards & opportunities:

- **Top Abstract Prizes** in the amount of €10,000 for the five best submitted abstracts. The prizes will be awarded to the first author, who should also be the presenting author, to qualify. The money should be spent on future research, and potential winners will be asked to supply brief plans for this before the prize is awarded. **Where the prize is awarded for a multi-centre study sponsored by industry, the author will be expected to waive the monetary part of the prize.** This opportunity is only available for [UEG Associates](#).
- **Travel grants** - UEG awards 500 travel grants (up to €750 each) to support outstanding abstract presenters. Grants are based on scientific merit as evaluated by the Scientific Committee. Eligibility criteria include:
 - The travel grant application must be submitted together with the abstract submission. To apply, select the 'Travel Grant' option during submission; applications submitted by email will not be accepted.
 - Applicants must be 40 years old or younger (born on or after October 21, 1986).
 - The presenter's date of birth must be provided to be considered.
 - Each presenter can receive only one travel grant per UEG Week.
 - This application is only available for [UEG Young Associates](#).
- **National Scholar awards** - UEG recognises promising junior-level researchers by selecting the highest-scoring abstracts per country among those accepted for presentation at UEG Week. Awardees receive a travel grant. Please refer to the Travel Grant eligibility requirements, as the same criteria apply to the National Scholar Award.
- **Best Abstract Presentation Prizes** are honorary awards given in each abstract-based and Moderated Poster session, selected by session chairs for scientific quality and the overall impact of the presentation. These distinctions are independent of the Top Abstract Prize and are intended as recognition rather than financial reward.

- All accepted abstracts will be published in UEG Journal, in addition to the publication within the UEG Week online programme, the UEG Week congress platform and [Gutflix](#).

- All abstracts accepted as posters will be featured as E-Posters and showcased:
 - On-site for the duration of the congress (Sunday to Tuesday).
 - Virtually on the UEG Week platform, with a 3-minute pre-recorded option.
 - Post-congress in [Gutflix](#), ensuring long-term visibility for your research.
- Special Recognition for **Moderated Posters**: Selected abstracts will be presented on stage, offering enhanced visibility and engaging interaction with the audience.

- **Hot Topics in Precision Medicine:** Highlight innovations in translational and basic science. Please tick the box 'Hot topics in precision medicine' at the end of the abstract submission if applicable. This year, we are placing a special spotlight on **metabolic perspectives of gastrointestinal disorders**, and we encourage submissions that contribute to this rapidly evolving field.
- **Paediatric GI research:** The distinction between adult and paediatric patients is essential; therefore, you can submit your abstract as a **paediatric abstract**. Please tick the box 'Paediatric' at the end of the abstract submission if this applies to your abstract.
- **Digestive Disease Mechanism (DDM) Summit:** Following its highly successful debut, the DDM Summit returns with an exceptional 3-day programme featuring lectures, poster presentations, and interactive discussions led by top experts in the field of basic science. This year's theme is '**Cellular Drivers of Inflammation**', offering a great opportunity to showcase new advances in GI research.
