## **Volunteer Position: Gutflix Task Force Member**

### **About Gutflix**

UEG has developed [Gutflix](https://gutflix.eu/), a platform designed to provide personalised gastroenterology learning. Tailored to GI interests, Gutflix offers a comprehensive range of resources, including UEG Week recordings, online courses, clinical practice guidelines, 'Mistakes in...' articles, podcasts, and more (<https://gutflix.eu/>). Gutflix is an innovative system that combines a powerful content platform with semantic search and an intelligent recommender system to deliver personalized and relevant experiences for users.

Until 2030, Gutflix will be enriched with more features, including content summaries, quizzes, an underlying knowledge graph<sup>1</sup>, and will offer personalised learning journeys that users can complete. Based on a defined roadmap, different features will be released each year.

An external consultant team has been tasked with developing an ontology<sup>2</sup> based on which all Gutflix content will be categorised. This will serve as a backbone of all future features. To complement the work of the ontologists and our internal Technology and Innovation team, we are founding the new Gutflix Task Force.

### **About the Gutflix Task Force**

The task force will be composed of up to 8 active members who support UEG as volunteers and cover the key thematic areas of Gutflix. The task force will also include representatives of relevant UEG committees (Education Committee, Quality of Care Committee, Scientific Committee). The task force directly contributes to shaping the future of AI-driven, personalised medical education in UEG and ensures Gutflix becomes a leading personalised learning platform in gastroenterology. The task force will start work in June 2026 and finish by the end of 2030 in line with the UEG Strategic Plan.

As a task force member, you will take on key responsibilities that ensure the continued success of Gutflix:

- Review, evaluate and provide structured feedback on ontology
  - Critically assess the structure, consistency, and clinical relevance of the ontology developed by the external consultant.
  - Ensure alignment with current standards in gastroenterology and related medical fields
  - Advise on improvements to terminology, classification and categorisation
  - Identify gaps, ambiguities, or inconsistencies in the ontology
- Bridge clinical and technical perspectives
  - Translate clinical needs into actionable feedback for technical teams
  - Ensure that ontology outputs are meaningful and usable for clinicians, researchers, and other end users

Knowledge graphs are used to store interlinked descriptions of entities, while encoding the free-form semantics or relationships underlying these entities. - Evaluate how Gutflix is experienced by end users (clinicians and trainees) and provide actionable recommendations to improve usability, navigation, and learning journeys
- Define key requirements for future Gutflix features from a user perspective, e.g. How long should the summaries be for each format type etc.
- Support quality assurance and validation
  - Contribute to defining validation criteria and review processes
  - Help ensure outputs meet high scientific and usability standards
- Collaborate with internal teams
  - Work closely with the Technology & Innovation team and the Education Unit within the UEG Headquarters Management
  - Participate in regular (online) meetings, workshops, and feedback sessions

### Requirements

- Be a UEG Associate and active Gutflix user
- MD or PhD in the field of Digestive Health
- Fluency in English (written and spoken)
- Be available for (online) meetings during European business hours

We welcome applications from both early-career and experienced professionals who have the time to take on volunteer work. We are looking for people who are motivated, committed and responsive.

**Term:** starting June 1, 2026, for minimum a year, with the possibility of extension

### Expected time commitment:

10 hours / month – asynchronous reviews, and online task force meetings

This is a voluntary position with no remuneration foreseen. Work will mainly be done online.
